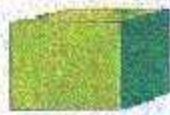

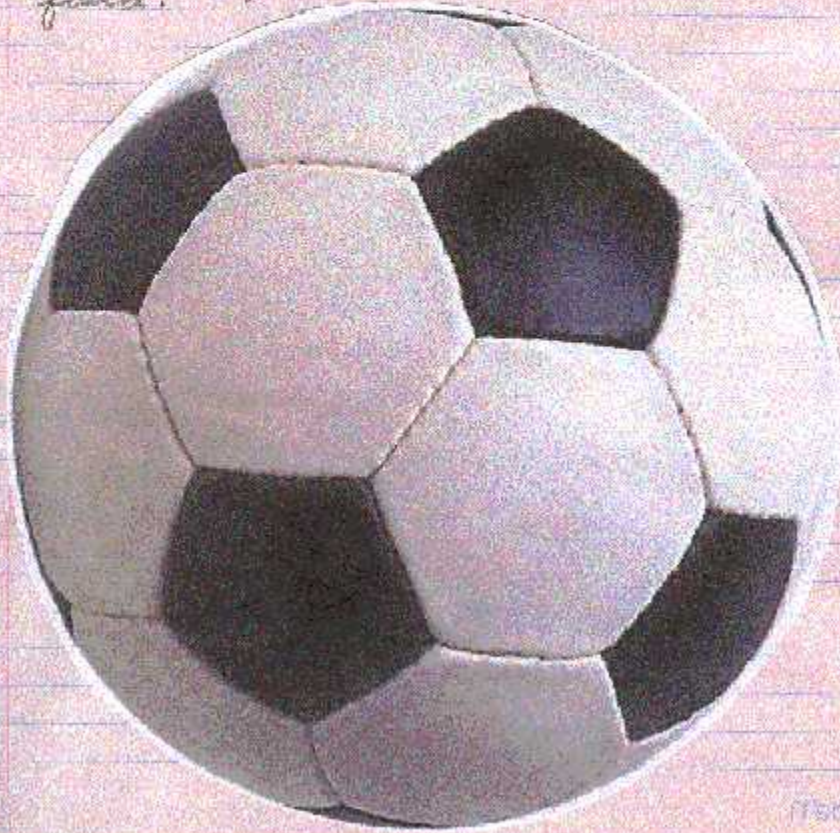
January 20th
